Applied & Fine Art/Design/Cartooning/Illustration/Photography: up to 20 pieces of inventoried work submitted electronically, on PowerPoint, or thumb drive

Film incl. Animation & Video: no more than 5-minute reel on PowerPoint or thumb drive

Dance/Music/Theater: no more than 5-minute reel on PowerPoint or thumb drive

Literary: excerpts from several original pieces, no more than 5 double-spaced pages sent as an attachment
